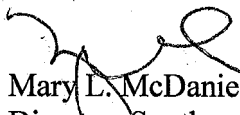
Dear Mr. Armstrong:

On August 17–20, 2015, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Williams Olefins Feedstock LLC procedures in Houston Texas. As a result of the inspection, Williams was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 25, 2017, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Williams submitted its amended procedures on March 15, 2017. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
