From February 23, 2016 through April 14, 2016, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of EPL Pipeline, LLC (EPL) procedures in Houston, TX. As a result of the inspection EPL was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 2, 2017, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

EPL submitted its amended procedure on June 9, 2017 (received in the PHMSA office on June 12, 2017). My staff reviewed the amended procedure, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
