From February to September 29, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Enterprise Crude Pipeline, LLC (Enterprise) procedures for Operations and Maintenance, and Integrity Management in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection Enterprise was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 20, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Enterprise submitted its response with revised procedures and further evidence on January 30, 2019. My staff reviewed the submitted procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
