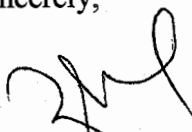
Dear Mr. Cunningham:

From November 27, 2017 to March 23, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of procedures for Osage Pipeline (Osage) in Artesia, New Mexico. As a result of the inspection, a Notice of Amendment was issued to Osage on October 12, 2018.

Osage Pipeline submitted its amended procedures on December 10, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
