From December 12, 2017 to December 13, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of LOLA-Louisiana to Longview pipeline system. As a result of the inspection, Permian Express Partners, LLC (Permian/Sunoco/Energy Transfer) was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on January 16, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Permian submitted its amended procedures on February 15, 2019 and April 5, 2019. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice have been corrected.
