On multiple dates between December 5, 2017 and March 26, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Delek Logistics Operating, LLC (Delek) procedures in El Dorado, Arkansas. As a result of the inspection, Delek was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 2, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Delek submitted its amended procedures on August 5, 2019 and December 5, 2019, respectively. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
