From March 2, 2020 through March 5, 2020, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Enable Gas Transmission, LLC's (Enable) Control Room Management Program and records in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection PHMSA issued a Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order on November 3, 2020 and a Final Order on February 2, 2021.

Enable submitted its response and a new procedure, *OM-216: Field Maintenance Communication Protocol* on Mach 16, 2021. PHMSA staff reviewed the response and determined that Enable has complied with the terms of the Final Order.
