Dear Mr. Chapman:

From March 8, 2019 through January 8, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of TC Energy's subsidiary, ANR Pipeline Company's procedures for its Southwest North (Mid America Region - Southeast Mainline) Pipelines, Loop Lines 501, 1-501, and 2-501, and System 1168 in Louisiana, Mississippi, Arkansas, Tennessee, and Kentucky. As a result of the inspection, ANR Pipeline Company was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 16, 2020, which proposed an amendment of its procedures.

ANR Pipeline Company submitted its amended procedures on December 16, 2020, followed by a supplemental amendment of those procedures on February 8, 2021. PHMSA staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
