Dear Mr. Yatauro:

From September 14, 2020 through October 30, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected the plans and procedures of ExxonMobil Pipeline Company (ExxonMobil) for its hazardous liquid pipeline systems located in Texas, Louisiana, and the Gulf of Mexico. As a result of the inspection, ExxonMobil was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on April 27, 2021, which proposed amendments to ExxonMobil's procedures.

After being granted a time extension for its response deadline, ExxonMobil submitted its amended and supplementary procedures on July 8, 2021. PHMSA staff reviewed these procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
