On March 7, 2022, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to ExxonMobil Pipeline Company (ExxonMobil), a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order requirement to conduct atmospheric corrosion inspections with particular attention to pipe at pipe supports and assessed a Civil Penalty.
