Dear Mr. Hinz:

From October 26, 2020 through October 29, 2020, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Sabine Pass LNG, L.P.'s (SPLNG) plans and procedures by virtual teleconference. As a result of the inspection, SPLNG was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 29, 2021, which outlined inadequacies in its procedures.

SPLNG submitted its amended procedures prior to the issuance of the Notice. PHMSA staff reviewed these procedures and determined them to be adequate; therefore, as indicated in the Notice no further correspondence was required from SPLNG. According to 49 CFR § 190.206, an operator is allowed 30 days following receipt of a notice to submit written comments, revised procedures, or a request for a hearing under § 190.211.

This letter is to inform you that this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
