Dear Mr. Fusco:

From March 9, 2020 through March 12, 2020, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Sabine Pass LNG, L.P.'s (Cheniere) procedures and records at its terminal in Cameron, Louisiana. As a result of the inspection, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment to Cheniere dated September 24, 2021, which required amendments to its procedures.

Cheniere submitted its amended and supplementary procedures on October 28, 2021. PHMSA staff has reviewed these procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
