Dear Ms. McDaniel:

This responds to your letter dated 4 October 2021, which outlines Notice of Amendment CPF 4-2021-054-NOA. Linde has reviewed the three apparent inadequacies your letter lists were found within Linde's procedures and has taken the following actions:

1. Linde has revised Section 26.2 of OM-2287, *Operating and Maintenance Manual for Regulated Hydrogen Gas Pipelines* to add the requirements of § 192.187.
2. Linde has revised Section 13 of OM-2287 and Section 4.6 of T-6, *Hydrostatic Testing of Pipelines* to add the requirements of § 192.515. T-6 has been redesignated as &CM V-PT 1001.
3. Linde revised Section 32.3 and added Section 32.4 and Addendum D to OM-2287. This revision adds the requirements of § 192.476 and § 192.477.

&CM V-PT 1001 and the revised Sections of OM-2287 are enclosed with this letter.
