From April 12, 2021 to April 14, 2021, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected DCP Midstreams's (DCP) Integrity Management Procedures in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, DCP was issued a Notice of Amendment on December 22, 2021, which proposed amendment of your Integrity Management Plan procedures.

DCP submitted its revised procedures on April 1, 2022. My staff reviewed the revised procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
