WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST

1. Withdrawal of hearing request

On October 17, 2022, pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §§ 190.208(b)(4) and 190.211(b), Enterprise Crude Pipeline LLC (Enterprise) requested a hearing to discuss the alleged violation and proposed compliance order contained in the Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order (NOPV/PCO) issued by the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) on August 4, 2022.

Subsequent to Enterprise's hearing request, Enterprise and representatives of PHMSA's Southwest Region (the Region) negotiated the matters addressed in the NOPV/PCO. The parties have reached an agreed resolution in the matter which, per 49 C.F.R. § 190.219(a), is reflected in a Consent Agreement signed by appropriate representatives of Enterprise and the Region, and a Consent Order signed by PHMSA's Associate Administrator for Pipeline Safety on April 3, 2023.

The parties' agreed resolution obviates the need for a hearing in this matter. Accordingly, Enterprise hereby withdraws its October 17, 2022 hearing request.
