Dear Mr. Morton:

From May 3, 2021, through September 30, 2021, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Enterprise Crude Pipeline LLC's (Enterprise) Seaway 30-inch Crude System, Houston Crude System, and Midland Crude System in Oklahoma and Texas. As a result of the inspection, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment to Enterprise Crude Pipeline LLC on August 31, 2022, which proposed amendments to its procedures.

Enterprise Crude Pipeline LLC submitted its final amended procedures on September 23, 2022. PHMSA staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears the inadequacies identified in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
