From July 21, through October 18, 2021, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), inspected Kinetica Deepwater Express, LLC's (KDE) records following an incident that occurred on July 13, 2021, on its pipeline ID 341, El Paso Platform 327-A, in Eugene Island, Louisiana. Kinetica Partners, LLC (Kinetica), the parent company of KDE, owns and operates over 1,800 miles of natural gas transmission and gathering pipelines.

Based on PHMSA's review of the documentation Kinetica provided, it has been determined that Kinetica has complied with the terms of this Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed, and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
