On June 15, 2022, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an onsite pipeline safety inspection of DCP Midstream (DCP) Marysville Storage Field in Marysville, Michigan. As a result of the inspection, DCP was issued a Final Order (Order) in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order and Civil Penalty assessment.

Based on PHMSA's review of the documentation DCP provided and with confirmation of payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that DCP has complied with the terms of this Order.
