By letter dated May 26, 2022, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety, issued a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty, and Proposed Compliance Order to Denbury Gulf Coast Pipelines, LLC. On March 24, 2023, the allegations were resolved in a Consent Agreement and Order, which required payment of a civil penalty and certain corrective measures.

Based on PHMSA's review of the documentation Denbury provided, it has been determined that Denbury has complied with the terms of this Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed, and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
