Dear Mr. Bacon:

From February 7 through May 13, 2022, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected the operations and maintenance procedures for the Enterprise MAPCO SW Pipeline System (Enterprise). As a result of the inspection, Enterprise was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on December 14, 2022, which proposed amendment of its procedures.

Enterprise requested a time extension to respond to the Notice on January 9, 2023. The request was for an additional 60 days to respond to the Notice. PHMSA granted the time extension request on January 13, 2023, with an updated response date of March 14, 2023.

Enterprise responded to the Notice on March, 14, 2023 and submitted its amended procedures on April 10, 2023. PHMSA reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
