From March 21 through November 22, 2022, a representative of the Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), Southwest Region, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted a pipeline safety inspection of UCAR Pipeline Inc.'s (UCAR) gaseous ethylene system in Texas and Louisiana via video teleconference. As a result of the inspection, UCAR was issued a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) of the Pipeline Safety Regulations, Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations in the above-referenced case. This NOPV included a Compliance Order.

Based on PHMSA's review of the documentation UCAR provided, it has been determined that UCAR has complied with the terms of this Compliance Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed, and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
