Dear Ms. Faraca:

From March 11 through March 15, 2024, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC's (Columbia Gas) procedures in Chesapeake, Virginia. As a result of the inspection, Columbia Gas was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 26, 2024, proposing amendment of Columbia Gas' operations and maintenance procedures.

Columbia Gas, through its parent company TC Energy, submitted its amended procedures on September 23, 2024. PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedure, and it appears that the inadequacy outlined in this Notice of Amendment has been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
