Dear Mr. Long:

From March 6 to October 17, 2023, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) conducted an on-site inspection of Enable Gas Transmission, LLC's (Enable) integrity management plan in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Enable Gas Transmission, LLC is a subsidiary of Energy Transfer, LP.

As a result of the inspection, Enable was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 2, 2024, which proposed amendment of its procedures. Enable submitted its amended procedures on December 4, 2024. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary, and this case is now closed.
