From April 17 to 19, 2023, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Eagle LNG Partners (Eagle LNG) procedures for its Maxville LNG facility in Jacksonville, FL. As a result of the inspection, Eagle LNG was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 28, 2024, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Eagle LNG submitted its amended procedures on October 1, 2024. PHMSA reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
