From February 27 to August 23, 2023, of the on-site inspection, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Targa Resources Operating, LLC's (Targa) procedures regarding its crude oil gathering system on the Fort Berthold Reservation in North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, Targa was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 22, 2024, which proposed amendment of Targa's operations and maintenance procedures.

Targa submitted its amended procedures on November 18, 2024. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
