From March 11, 2024 to September 27, 2024, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted inspection of Valero Terminal and Distribution Company's (Valero) integrity management program procedures. As a result of the inspection, Valero was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 22, 2025, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Valero submitted its amended procedures on July 23, 2025. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
