From February 24 through June 13, 2025, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Shell Pipeline Company L.P.'s (SPLC) Corrosion Control Inspection and Maintenance Manual in Houston, Texas.

As a result of the inspection, on December 2, 2025, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), issued to Shell Pipeline Company, L.P., a Notice of Amendment in the above-referenced case.

On January 20, 2026, Shell Pipeline Company, L.P., submitted its amended procedures. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacy outlined in this Notice of Amendment has been corrected.
