From June 4 to 6, 2024, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected East Tennessee Natural Gas, LLC's¹ (ETNG) liquefied natural gas (LNG) facility in Kingsport, Tennessee.

As a result of the inspection, ETNG was issued a Final Order on November 24, 2025. The Final Order included a Compliance Order. Based on additional information you have provided, and the subsequent meeting and demonstration conducted with Southwest Region personnel, it has been determined that ETNG has successfully complied with the terms of the Order.
