From August 13 through August 15, 2024, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation's^a (Niagara) liquefied natural gas (LNG) facility in Providence, Rhode Island.

As a result of the inspection, Niagara was issued a Final Order on November 19, 2025. This Order included a Compliance Order. Based on our review of the documentation you provided, it has been determined that Niagara has successfully complied with the terms of this Order.
