From April 16, 2024, to October 10, 2024, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected EnLink Processing Services, LLC's (EnLink) procedures for operations and maintenance in Dallas, Texas.

On August 20, 2025, PHMSA issued the Notice, CPF 4-2025-046-NOA, to EnLink proposing amendments of its operations and maintenance procedures. EnLink provided its response to the Notice, and submitted its amended procedures, on September 19, 2025.

PHMSA has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
