On August 16, 2010 a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Williams Field Services' procedures for atmospheric corrosion inspection at your PGX Pipeline at Parachute, Colorado. As a result of the inspection, Williams Field Services was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 28, 2011 which proposed amendment of your procedures.
