On August 02 – 06, 2010, August 09 - 13, 2010, and September 13 – 15, 2010, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of your Operations and Maintenance procedures at Commerce City, Colorado. As a result of the inspection, we issued your company a Notice of Amendment on June 15, 2011, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
