On July 25 through 29, 2016, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Chevron Products Company's procedures for the Willbridge Facilities in Portland, Oregon. As a result of the inspection, Chevron Products Company was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 17, 2017 which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Chevron Products Company submitted its amended procedures on September 12, 2017. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
