Dear Mr. Roedell:

On August 1 through August 4, 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Greater Aneth/Elk Petroleum's procedures in Denver, Colorado. As a result of the inspection, Greater Aneth/Elk Petroleum was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 16, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Elk Petroleum submitted its amended procedures on April 18, 2018. PHMSA subsequently held a meeting with Elk Petroleum representatives on August 16, 2018, to discuss the inadequacies of Elk Petroleum's April 18, 2018 submittal. Elk Petroleum resubmitted procedures on December 28, 2018, to address the remaining inadequacies. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
