Dear Ms. Thonen:

During the week of May 14 through 17, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Suncor Energy (U.S.A.) Pipeline Company's (Suncor) procedures in Cheyenne, Wyoming. As a result of the inspection, Suncor was issued a Notice of Amendment on December 6, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

On February 25, 2019, PHMSA granted Suncor an extension until June 30, 2019 to submit amended procedures.

Suncor Energy submitted its amended procedures on June 26, 2019, received on June 28, 2019. PHMSA staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
