Closure Letter**

Dear Mr Carbaugh:

From July 11 through 13, 2017, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Aircraft Services International Group's (ASIG) Integrity Management Plan (IMP), and portions of other procedures which are incorporated in the IMP, in Anchorage, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, ASIG was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 4, 2018, which proposed amendments of your procedures. Menzie's Aviation is now the operator of the ASIG facilities in Anchorage.

Menzie's Aviation submitted its amended procedures on July 5, 2018 and December 10, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
