On November 5, 2018 through November 16, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of AmeriGas Propane LP's (AmeriGas) procedures in Maui, Kona, and Oahu, Hawaii. As a result of the inspection, AmeriGas was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 16, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

AmeriGas submitted its amended procedures on July 3, 2019. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
