On July 22 through 26, 2019, representatives of the California Public Utilities Commission on behalf of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) procedures for the natural gas transmission system in Sacramento, California. As a result of the inspection, SMUD was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 3, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
