This is in response to your letter dated February 28, 2020, regarding revisions to Coalinga's operator qualification (OQ) plan. The City of Coalinga has incorporated the changes requested in its OQ Plan and is otherwise complying as follows.

Regarding §192.805(i), a procedure has been added to provide for notification to PHMSA and the CPUC in the event Coalinga significantly modifies its program. The added language is within "Section VIII. Change Management Process" and reads as follows.

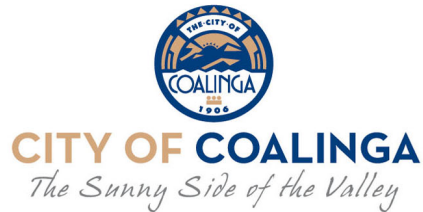
