During the weeks of January 28 through February 1, March 11 through 15, and April 1 through 5, 2019, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Plains All-American Pipeline, LP's (PAA) procedures for the Beartooth, Bighorn, and Casper Units in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, PAA was issued (via email) a Notice of Amendment on September 25, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

PAA submitted its amended procedures, dated November 9, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
