Notice of Amendment for Lompoc Oil & Gas Plant**

Dear Mr. Hubbard

Freeport-McMoRan Oil & Gas is in receipt of the subject Notice of Amendment (NOA).

We pride ourselves in conducting safe operations at all our facilities and pipelines. As noted by the audit team during the LOGP Control Room Management audit in 2020, our actual field procedures for pipeline operations are safe, but there are certain portions of the written pipeline operating procedures that are vague or unclear, or that do not adequately capture the actual field procedures that are used in practice by the control room operators and other operations staff in support of pipeline operations.

This letter is to inform you that we will not be contesting the NOA and will be making appropriate changes to our written operating procedures to address all the inadequate items. Due to the number of specific items to address, and the time that will be required by operations and engineering staff to address all the items, we request a time extension. We propose to submit the amended procedures on or before December 10, 2021.

For your additional information, attached is a tabulation identifying each item from the NOA, together with our action plan.

We believe that this fulfills the response requirement for this NOA. Should you require anything further, please do not hesitate to contact me.
