From May 17 through 21, 2021, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Harvest Alaska, LLC's (Harvest) procedures for the Northstar Liquid Pipeline near Prudhoe Bay, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, Harvest Alaska was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 30, 2022, which proposed amendment of Harvest's procedures.

Harvest Alaska submitted its amended procedures on April 28, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
