On November 10, 2022, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Belle Fourche Pipeline Co.'s written procedures in Casper, Wyoming.

As a result of the inspection, Belle Fourche Pipeline Co. was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 1, 2022 that required it to amend its procedures. Belle Fourche Pipeline Co. submitted its amended procedures to PHMSA on March 28, 2022.

My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected. This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
