This letter is written in response to the Notice of Amendment (NOA) dated March 1, 2022 to Tad True, President, Belle Fourche Pipeline Company (BFPL), which was written as a result of the inspection conducted between August and November 2021 of the Belle Fourche Donkey Creek hazardous liquid pipeline system in Wyoming. The NOA alleges one apparent inadequacy of BFPL's written procedures related to testing and inspection criteria for overpressure safety devices, and requires BFPL to submit an amended form *PL-504 Safety Device Inspection Report* within 30 days of receipt of the NOA.

To address PHMSA's concern, BFPL has modified O&M form *PL-504 Safety Device Inspection Report* to include the testing and inspection criteria described in item 1 of the NOA. Please see Attachment A for a copy of the modified form.

We trust the modification addresses PHMSA's concern and ask that the notice of amendment be closed accordingly.

This letter is not a waiver of Belle Fourche's legal rights under the Notice of Amendment in CPF 5-2022-026-NOA, and is without admission of fact or law.
