On August 16 through August 19, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Phillips 66's procedures for its Portland Terminal in Portland, Oregon. As a result of the inspection, Phillips 66 was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 25, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Phillips 66 submitted its amended procedures on May 20, 2022, with an additional revision of the procedure submitted on May 25, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
