From September 12 through the 15, 2022, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Menzies Aviation's (Menzies) procedures in Anchorage, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, Menzies was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 1, 2023, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Menzies submitted its amended procedures on March 27, 2023. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
