From November 2 through December 8, 2022, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted a virtual inspection of AmeriGas's procedures for operations and maintenance of their liquified petroleum distribution systems in Hawaii. As a result of the inspection, AmeriGas Propane, L.P. was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 18, 2023, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

AmeriGas Propane, L.P submitted its amended procedures on April 26, 2023. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
