Develop and execute a statewide media campaign promoting recent changes to the dig law; hire an attorney who understands damage prevention law (Elements 5 and 7).

Accomplishments for this period (Item 1 under Article IX, <u>Section 9.01 Progress Report</u>: "A comparison of actual accomplishments to the objectives established for the period.")

Element 5:

The MPSC has partnered with MS 811 and member utilities in a statewide "Call Before You Dig" cable media campaign highlighting safety and enforcement for violators of the dig law. This message is being used in television commercials and online messages. The original estimate was 12,000 commercials and 300,000 on-line messages. Due to additional partners, we received 83,390 commercials and 593,626 online messages as of August 25, 2019.

The MPSC provided a 4-week "Call Before You Dig" radio campaign that included 60 messages to 62 affiliate radio stations. Each message was 30 seconds long. Total cost averaged \$4.03 per message.

No targeted social media campaign was conducted.

Element 7:

Funds were used to provide an experienced attorney who was able to counsel the Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Board, Executive Committee, and Executive Secretary on matters related to enforcement of Mississippi excavation law. During this time period, the volume of

alleged violation reports submitted to the Board increased in both volume and types of violations. The attorney spent time with and counseled the Executive Committee and Executive Secretary regarding the substantive and procedural sufficiency of alleged violations. He also counseled the Board and Executive Committee on ways to improve the alleged violation report process. He worked with Board and Pipeline Safety Division leadership on strategies to deter habitual offenders of the Mississippi dig laws. Finally, he spent time identifying Board rules and regulations that need to be amended to improve the overall enforcement process.

Quantifiable Metrics/Measures of Effectiveness (Item 2 under Article IX, <u>Section 9.01 Progress Report</u>: "Where the output of the project can be quantified, a computation of the cost per unit of output.")

One Call ticket volume is up 10.43% in the period of January 1 – November 1, 2019 compared to the same period in 2018.

Each call received generates approximately 5 utility locate requests. Locate requests have increased 13.7% from the same period last year.

Due to staff changes at the Commission, we were unable to provide the social media campaign and funds will be returned. We do not feel this had an effect on our media campaign.
