Specific Objective(s) of the Agreement

The Safety Commission is requesting funding to cover the cost of the license and Spanish translation service for an LMS that would host and deliver online stakeholder education courses. The online courses will focus on topics that the Safety Commission has encountered in complaint hearings and will be offered to parties found to be in violation of the Excavation Requirements Law during future complaint hearings. Workscope

Element 4 (Partnership in Employee Training): Participation by operators, excavators, and other stakeholders in developing and implementing effective employee training programs to ensure that operators, the one-call center, the enforcing agency, and the excavators have partnered to design and implement training for the employees of operators, excavators, and locators.

Accomplishments for the Grant Period


- The existing English version of the online stakeholder education course was reviewed and updated.
- Translation of the existing online stakeholder education course into Spanish was completed, with three
 rounds of reviews to ensure that the translation is clear, concise and analogous to the English version
 of the course.

Quantifiable Metrics/Measures of Effectiveness

The online stakeholder education course was previously available to up to 1,500 users, but it is now available to 8,000 users, which is an increase of more than 500%.

In addition, providing the online stakeholder education course content in Spanish makes the content readily available to employees of operators, excavators, and locators for whom English is their secondary language.
