

Attendee Survey Result Notes


- **62 Survey responses received**

1. What stakeholder group do you represent?



2. Please rate the value received from the Forum:




3. Did the Forum meet your expectations?

- The understanding that limited resources are applied to the most pressing needs.


5. Do you expect to use the Forum results?




6. How do you plan to use Forum results?
